## TO ALL NATIONAL TEAMS:

This is the first Bulletin for all FAI members, which is giving information on the 28<sup>th</sup> World Gliding Championships. For the first time the Worlds are to be held in four FAI Classes ( Open, Standard, 15 m. & 18 m. Class).

We'll be very glad to welcome World's best pilots in Leszno in 8 months.

The Pre-Worlds held in Leszno from 10<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> August 2002 offered a good opportunity to get a new experience. There were 10 gliders in the Standard Class and 17 gliders in the mixed Open Class from all over the world participating in the competition. We had 8 interesting tasks.

We do hope the next year Championships will be successful, and new Champions will be revealed in a fair competition.

## I LOCATION:

The Championships will be held at Leszno airfield (EPLS)

Situated in the Western Poland between two big cities: Poznań and Wrocław and about 300 km west of Warsaw.

The 100 hectares grass airfield has two parallel strips (E- W) of 920 x 100 m and two parallel N-S strips of 880 x 100 m. (Appendix 4)

Elevation: 94 m. / 308 feet AMSL.

There is a big parking area for trailers and gliders, with water supply, close to the camp site and club hotel. The airfield accommodates both the Central Gliding School of the Aero Club of Poland and the Aero Club of Leszno (Aeroklub Leszczyński).

The Polish Nationals in the Open mixed Class (with handicapping) will be held in Leszno either in the second half of May or in the first half of June. We'll do our best to run this competition as similarly to the World Championships as possible. We would like to cordially invite all the pilots to participate.

## ➔ V CHAMPIONSHIPS CLASSES:

The 28<sup>th</sup> World Gliding Championships is the first Championships to be held in four FAI Classes, according to Chapter 7, Section 3 of the FAI Sporting Code.

The Championships Classes are:

▶ Open Class	▶ Standard Class
▶ FAI 15m. Class	▶ FAI 18m. Class

## VI NUMBER OF COMPETITORS, ENTRY FORMS & LIMITATION:

Each NAC may enter a maximum of:

- ◆ Two pilots in Standard and 15m. Class
- ◆ One pilot in Open and 18m. Class

- ◆ One substitute reserve pilot in each class. A reserve pilot will normally only replace a nominated pilot in the event of a withdrawal. Reserve pilots will be admitted after 15<sup>th</sup> March 2003 only in a class where vacancies exist, provided entry fees for the officially entered pilots have been received.
- ◆ The current World Gliding Champions may compete as additional members of their team in their respective classes. They must, however, be entered by their NAC.
- ◆ The total number of allowable entries shall not exceed 120 total and maximum number of gliders in any classes are 50 (according to annex A).
- ◆ Entries can be accepted only from the NAC on the official entry forms. Please send the preliminary entries, using the forms enclosed -Appendix 3 to reach us by 31<sup>st</sup> Dec. 2002.  
The official entry forms for the final entries will be send with the Bulletin No 2. These must be returned to reach us by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2003. Additionally, please send us two photographs of each Pilot and Team Captain.  
We'd prefer one passport type and one non-passport type picture.  
Each entry will be accepted only when the entry fee has been credited to the Organizers account. (next point)
- ◆ Bulletins will be mailed ONLY to those NAC's requesting them to be posted. Otherwise all the information will be on the official web site – **www.wgc2003.pl**. You will be notified via email of any new information, Bulletins, etc.

## § VII ENTRY FEE, AEROTOW FEE & LANDING FEE:

- ◆ The Entry Fee per participating glider is **750 EURO**, which covers all operational costs during the Championships but excludes aerotow fees. The full amount of 750 EURO is to be paid to the organizer's account, with all transfer fees covered by the competitor separately.

## IX QUALIFICATIONS:

A competitor must be a citizen or resident of the country of the entering NAC and satisfy the conditions of the FAI Sporting Code, General Section 3.8 on citizenship and representation, and must:

- have flown at least 250 hours as pilot in command, of which at least 100 hours must be in gliders;
- have an FAI Sporting Licence validated for the year 2003;
- hold a Glider Pilot Licence issued or endorsed by authorities of the country where the glider is registered;
- hold a FAI silver badge;
- have competed in at least two National Championships;

## X RULES:

The FAI Sporting Code General Section and Section 3 with its Annexes will apply.

A draft of Rules & Local Rules will be distributed to the Rule Committee of the IGC, all NACs and IGC Delegates in December, 2002. Its final version, after the IGC approval, will be attached to the Bulletin 3 and sent to all Team Managers.

Possible suggestions on amendments may be send to the address of the organizer (see page 2) until 30<sup>th</sup> November 2002.

## XI GNSS:

The flights will be controlled by a **GNSS Flight Recorder (FR) ONLY** carried on board of each glider. Two GNSS FRs may be used. A second flight recorder may be used as backup but the data from the backup FR may be analysed only if the GNSS trace of the primary recorder is not complete.

All GNSS units approved by the IGC before 26<sup>th</sup> May 2003 will be accepted.

Please note that before the first competition day, valid GNSS FR calibration certificate for primary and secondary FRs will be required.
